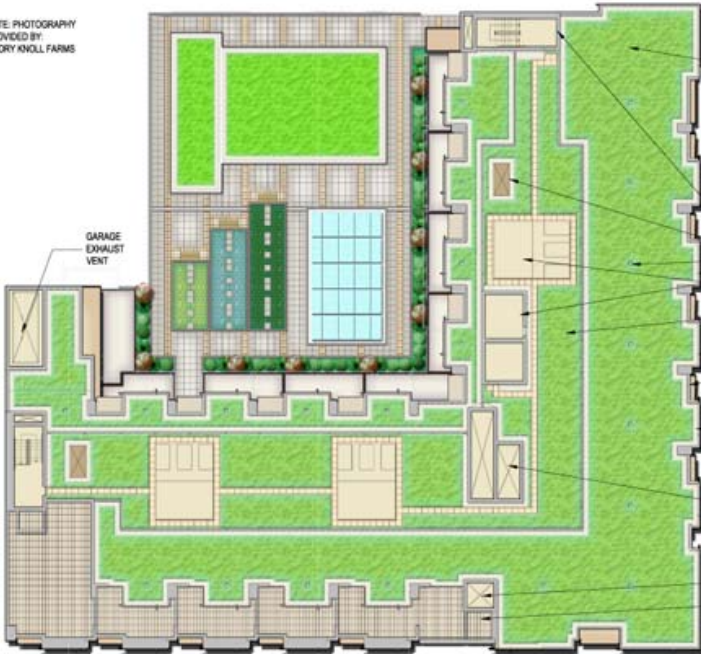


Capital Gateway Rooftop Terrace Washington, D.C.

Plant Material: 4 in. deep extensive assembly, perennials, shrubs, and trees in the planters.

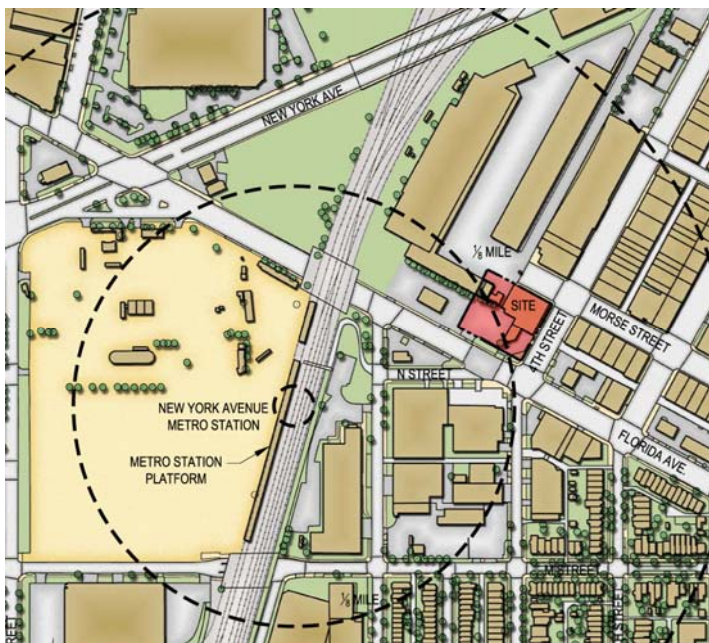
